




Parking and Access

Woodsong is a 20-acre site just outside the village of Pentre-bach, Powys. If you're coming by car, simply head to Pentre-bach, postcode LD3 8UB. (You can also enter the Shoemaker's Arms in your sat-nav - the pub is in the middle of the village.)

Our half-day retreats - foraging and bushcraft - begin with a meet-up in the Shoemaker's car park; from there we set off on foot and begin the fun.

For day sessions, you can park in the car park or along the street - the big blue spots show the best road-side parking. (The small green spots are the start of the track down to Woodsong.)



The track we'll be following is rutted and uneven, often with nice big water pools, so please bring sturdy, waterproof footwear. Being Wales, we want to be prepared for rain, so waterproof outer garments are recommended!

In the summer months, hats, sun glasses, sunscreen and insect repellent are all advisable.
